Position	Responsibilities/Pre-requisites
Administration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check in participants and answer general event questions • Direct participants to clinics and lessons, assist with special guest population • Keep check-in area clean and tidy, organize packing and shipping • Other responsibilities as requested by the Event Managers
Continuing Education Assistant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Print schedules • Keep continuing education area clean and tidy • Assist participants in locating their classes/instructors • Other responsibilities as requested by the Continuing Education Manager
Instructor – Adaptive Alpine Skiing/Snowboard Lessons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist with teach lessons for youth and adults with physical disabilities (on snow position) • PSIA-AASI Level I ADAPTIVE CERTIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED • Lift ticket provided for assigned lessons. Helmets must be worn while on snow • Must commit to at least 2 consecutive days of lessons or 3 days throughout the event • Limited Spaces available. Interested in applying to volunteer? Social Events Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist with the set up/breakdown of evening social events. • Deal cards at casino night (Blackjack and Texas Hold ‘Em)
Race Volunteer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist with race administration (run results, hand out race packets/numbers, etc.) • Must be able to independently ski/snowboard Blue/Black terrain. <i>Helmet must be worn.</i>
Curling and Sled Hockey	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This is an on-ice position. Assist with righting players on ice, getting in and out of equipment, retrieval of stones • Please arrive early to receive a brief training
Special Guest Assistant	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist with Special Guest population • Facilitation of lessons - getting students matched with instructors • Facilitation of equipment fitting - getting participants through equipment check-out process • Other responsibilities as requested by Special Guest Managers
Lunch	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist with preparation and serving of lunch (by equipment truck / outside)
Transportation/Van Driver	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Transport passengers and equipment during event (7 passenger - 15 passenger vehicles provided by DSUSA). Requires driving in variable conditions • Must be 25 or older and provide copy of clean and valid driver’s license
